MAYOR PRO-TEM ADRIENNE WESSELS OPENED THE MEETING FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING:

FY-2025 CDBG GRANT PROJECT; PROPOSED WASTERWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

THE CITY OF CHEROKEE IS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT THROUGH THE OKLAHOMA DEPT OF COMMERCE TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S WASTEWATER SYSTEM.

THE PROJECT WILL BENEFIT LOW TO MODERATE LEVELED INCOME CITIZENS.

THE GRANT REQUEST AMOUNT WILL BE \$600,000.00.

THE PROJECT WILL NOT LIKELY RESULT IN THE DISPLACEMENT OR RELOCATION OF ANY CITIZENS OR RESIDENTS.

THE CITY OF CHEROKEE WILL PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO GROUPS REPRESENTATIVE OF PERSONS OF LOW AND MODERATE INCOME THAT MAY REQUEST ASSISTANCE IN DEVELOPING ANY PROPOSALS FOR THE PROJECT.

THE LEVELS AND TYPE OF ASSISTANCE TO BE PROVIDED IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY OF CHEROKEE AND DOES NOT NECESSARILY INCLUDE PROVIDING FUNDING TO SUCH GROUPS.

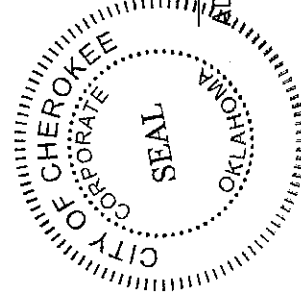
